STATE OF MAINE
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FOUR
AN ACT to Require that Meetings of Governing Bodies of Nonprofit Hospitals be Open to the Public.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 MRSA §1713 is enacted to read:
§1713. Open proceedings
The proceedings of every board of directors or other governing body of any hospital owned or oper- ated by a nonprofit corporation or nonprofit associa- tion shall be public proceedings, as defined in Title 1, chapter 13, subchapter I, and shall be open to the public as required in that subchapter.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 Hospitals owned or operated by nonprofit corpora-3 tions or nonprofit associations are utilized by Maine 4 citizens for essential health and medical services. 5 Public funds contribute to the revenues and opera-6 tions of hospitals. It is in the interest of Maine 7 people for all proceedings of the boards of directors 8 or other governing bodies of those hospitals to be 9 conducted in an open and public manner so that the 10 people can remain informed of the decisions and decision-making processes. Hospitals owned or operated by 11 the State or by local governmental units are already 12 13 subject to open meeting requirements.

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
