- 23 24 25	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
. 26 27 28 29 30	Whereas, the First Regular Session of the 111th Legislature established a select commission to study certain aspects of the workers' compensation system and established the date of April 30, 1984, as the reporting date for that commission; and
31 32 33	Whereas, delays in forming the commission and be- ginning its assigned study have resulted in a need for further time to complete its study; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 8 follows:

PL 1983, c. 479, §31, last ¶ is amended to read:

10 The commission shall report its full findings to 11 the Governor, the President of the Senate and the 12 Speaker of the House of Representatives, together 13 with any recommended legislation, no later that April 14 30, June 30, 1984.

15 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 16 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-17 proved.

## 18 STATEMENT OF FACT

19 The purpose of this bill is to extend the dead-20 line for reporting for the select commission studying 21 workers' compensation.
