9 1. Inspection fee. After considering the recom10 mendations of the board as provided in section 1033,

13 the commissioner shall set the inspection fee for
14 loads packed in Maine bags.

15 2. Statement of basis for fee. Upon request of 16 the board, the commissioner shall provide to the 17 board and other interested parties a written state-18 ment of the basis for the fee established under this 19 section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to clarify the responsibility of the Maine Potato Quality Control Board and the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources under the Maine potato quality control law.
