Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§l01." in the first paragraph in the 2nd, $3 r d$ and 4 th lines (page 1, lines 27 to 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "15 justices until June 30, 1985: 16 justices until June 30,1986 ; and 17 justices thereafter" and inserting in its place the following: ' 15 justices'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the first paragraph in the 5 th, 6 th and 7 th lines (page 2 , lines 18 to 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "until June 30, 1985; 8 judges at large until June 30,1986 ; and 9 judges at large thereafter"

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:
'An appropriation of $\$ 96,255$ is required to fund an additional justice and one judge in fiscal year 1984-85.'

STATEMENT OF EACT

This amendment provides for one additional Superior Court Justice and one additional District Court
