21 22 23 24 25	The first part of this amendment provides that the licensee under investigation shall receive a copy of all confidential materials submitted to the board under the Revised Statutes, Title 32, section 2105-A, subsection 3.
26 27 28 29 30	The 2nd part of this amendment removes a provision in the bill granting immunity from liability for persons who file complaints with the board. This provision is not typically found in other licensing laws and could encourage the filing of unfounded complaints.
