18 RESOLVE, for Laying of the County Taxes  
19 and Authorizing Expenditures of Sagadahoc  
20 County for the Year 1984.

22 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves  
23 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90  
24 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;  
25 and

26 Whereas, Sagadahoc County has certain expenses  
27 and liabilities which must be met as they become due;  
28 and

29 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the  
30 year 1984 hereinafter mentioned be immediately as-  
31 sessed in order to provide the required revenue for  
32 the county; and

33 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
34 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. Sagadahoc County; taxes apportioned. Resolved: That the following sum is hereby granted as a tax on Sagadahoc County to be apportioned, assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of paying debts and necessary expenses of the county as authorized herein, and for other purposes of law, for the calendar year 1984:

Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized. Resolved: That the following sums, based on the county budget filed in the office of the Secretary of State, are authorized as General Fund expenditures by the county during the calendar year 1984 in the specific total amounts of expenditures for personal services, contractual services, commodities and capital expenditures for each account in the county budget:
