26 27 28	Whereas, Penobscot County has certain expenses and liabilities which must be met as they become due; and
29 30 31 32	Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1984 hereinafter mentioned be immediately as- sessed in order to provide the required revenue for the county; and
33 34	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 4 therefore, be it
