Instructors of cosmetology No person may be engaged to instruct in any of the branches of cosmetology unless that person has a 14 15 16 certificate to practice cosmetology under this chap-17 ter, except physicians as specified. 18 The board and the Department of Educational and Cultural Services shall make rules for the examina-19 20 tion of applicants for certificates of registration 21 as instructors of cosmetology, in accordance with the 22 Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II. Examination applications shall 23 24 be furnished by the board. The application shall be filed with the secretary of the board and shall be 25 accompanied by an examination fee of \$50 which shall 26 27 include registration, if examination is satisfactory. 28 All certificates of registration as instructors shall 29 expire June 30th biennially. The renewal fee for in-30 structors shall be \$16 biennially. 31 Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-32 tions to read consecutively.
