23 24 25	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
26 27	Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and
28 29 30 31	Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to tentative collective bargaining agreements reached between the University of Maine and its employees will become due and payable immediately; and
32 33	Whereas, funding must be provided immediately if those obligations and expenses are to be met; and

23 24 25	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
26	STATEMENT OF FACT
27 28 29 30 31 32	The purpose of this bill is to provide funding to implement collective bargaining agreements between the University of Maine and its employees. The funding would also provide equivalent increases for confidential employees and employees not represented in collective bargaining.
