1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 8 follows:

9 Sec. 1. Study and report. The Department of Fi-10 nance . and Administration and the Municipal Valuation 11 Appeals Board shall jointly study the problem of cat-12 astrophic changes in municipal valuation as related 13 to the 2-year delay in state valuation and make a report containing recommendations for solutions, in-14 15 cluding legislation, if necessary, to the 112th Leg-16 islature by January 1, 1985.

17 Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are 18 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the 19 purposes of this Act.
