7 8 9 10 11	Amend the Senate Order in the last line by striking out the word and punctuation "Senate." and inserting in their place the following: 'Senate, except that Rules 1 and 5 shall be amended to read as follows:
12 13 14 15 16 17 18	1. The President shall take the chair at the time to which the Senate stands adjourned; but in case of his absence at such time, the Secretary shall preside until a President pro tempore be chosen the President pro tempore shall preside. In case of the absence of the President pro tempore, the Secretary shall preside until a President pro tempore is chosen.
19 20 21 22	5. The President shall have the right to name a Senator to perform the duties of the Chair during his absence; but the substitution shall not extend beyond an adjournment.
23 24 25 26 27 28	The President shall also have the right to appoint a Secretary of the Senate and an Assistant Secretary of the Senate to fill any vacancy that may occur in said office while the Legislature is not in session, to serve until the Senate in session shall elect a Secretary or Assistant Secretary.
29 30	The President shall have the authority to appoint legal counsel while the Legislature is in session.
