COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 63, L.D. 89,
8 Bill, "AN ACT Requiring Protective Headgear for all
9 Motorcycle, Motor Driven Cycle and Moped Riders."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after
11 the enacting clause and before the statement of fact
12 and inserting in its place the following:

13

'Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §1376, 5th ¶, as enacted by PL
14 1983, c. 415, is repealed and the following enacted
15 in its place:

Following successful completion of a driving
17 test, every person who operates a motorcycle or a mo-
18 tor driven cycle shall wear protective headgear for a
19 minimum period of 2 years.

20

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §1376, 6th ¶, as enacted by PL
21 1983, c. 415, is amended to read:

Every person who rides as a passenger on a motor-
23 cycle or motor driven cycle or in a sidcar attached
24 to a motorcycle or motor driven cycle which is oper-
25 ated by a driver within a period of ~~one year~~ 2 years
26 following successful completion of the motorcycle or
27 motor driven cycle driving test shall wear protective
28 headgear. All protective headgear prescribed in this
29 section shall conform with minimum standards of con-
30 struction and performance as prescribed by the Amer-
31 ican National Standards Institute specification Z
32 90.1 or by the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard
33 No. 218.'
