decision involving the duties and responsibilities of the road commissioner shall be made by the selectmen whose decision shall be final. His The road commissioner's compensation shall be such sum as the tewns shall annually vete therefer, which sum shall in ne case be less than \$1.50 a day for every day of actual service legislative body votes annually. He The road commissioner shall render to the selectmen monthly statements of his expenditures and receive no money from the treasury, except on the order of the selectmen.

If the selectmen determine that a condition exists in any town way which creates a hazard and renders the way unsafe for travelers with motor vehicles, the selectmen shall give written notice to the road commissioner of this condition and order him to eliminate it or take interim measures to protect the public within 24 hours. If the road commissioner fails to act as directed by the selectmen, the selectmen may enter contracts or take any other steps necessary to eliminate the safety hazard.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The legal authority of selectmen over road commissioners, particularly elected road commissioners, in the performance of their duties has been an uncertain area of law for decades. This bill clearly states that it is the selectmen who have final authority to decide the duties and responsibilities of the road commissioner where there is a conflict. It also makes clear that the selectmen can order a road commissioner to rectify a hazardous road condition and that their determination is final. This authority is extremely important since it is the municipality which can be held liable for accidents which occur as the result of negligence in the maintenance of town ways.
