20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 21 MRSA §241, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1973, c.  
23 414, §7, is amended to read:

24 3. Residence. In order to vote in any election,  
25 he shall have established a residence in this State  
26 and in the municipality in which he resides for 7  
27 days next prior to the election.
