COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 139, L.D. 164,
8 Bill, "AN ACT Requiring Clarification of Dates Upon
9 Which Local Property Tax Penalties Accrue."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the last
11 underlined paragraph before the statement of fact
12 (page 1, lines 26 to 32 in L.D.) and inserting in its
13 place the following:

'Each property tax bill issued by a municipality
shall clearly state the date interest will begin to
accrue on delinquent taxes.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that property tax bills
19 must state the date on which interest begins to ac-
20 crue on unpaid taxes.
