17 AN ACT to Lower the Storage Temperature of
18 Milk.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 7 MRSa §2903, 9th ¶, as amended by PL 1971, c.
23 164, §15, is further amended to read:

24 It shall be unlawful to sell or serve any milk,
25 skim milk, nonfat or fat-free milk, flavored milk or
26 flavored dairy drink, or low fat milk, fortified milk
27 and milk products in a hotel, soda fountain, restau-
28 rant, grocery store, hospital or similar establish-
29 ment which has not been maintained while in its pos-
30 session, at a temperature of 45° 40° Fahrenheit, or
31 less, in dry storage. Wet storage is specifically
32 prohibited.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill requires milk to be stored at 40° Fahr-
3 enheit, or less, in dry storage.

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
