17 AN ACT to Amend the Law Concerning Pension
18 Benefits for Dependents of Sheriffs.
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 30 MRSA §851 is amended to read:

23 §851. Pension for dependents

24 If a sheriff or deputy sheriff shall die as a re-
25 sult of injury received in line of duty, ~~except while~~
26 ~~engaged in the duty of serving civil process,~~ his
27 widow, or, if none, his minor child or children,
28 shall receive a pension equal to 1/2 of the pay of
29 such sheriff or deputy sheriff at the time of his
30 death, but in no case shall such pension be less than
31 \$1,000. Such pension shall be paid to the widow until
32 she dies or remarries and to a child or children un-
33 til they die or reach the age of 18 years. This sec-
34 tion shall apply to deputy sheriffs who are not em-
35 ployed at regular salaries.
