AN ACT to Extend the Shoreland Zone in some Municipalities.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
12 MRSA §4811, as amended by PL 1983, c. 458, §2, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
Notwithstanding the definition of shoreland areas in this section, the jurisdiction of municipal shoreland zoning ordinances may include any structure

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

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Construction built on docks, wharves, piers or other structures extending over and into the water do not fall under the jurisdiction of shoreland zoning ordinances. This bill allows municipalities to amend their shoreland zoning ordinances to include that construction.

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
