the return, have it attested by a majority of the municipal officers and send the duplicate copy forthwith to the Secretary of State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill removes the requirement that clerks tabulate election returns in duplicate on the election return forms provided by the State within 26 hours after the polls close. The bill also removes the requirement that the tabulation be done in the presence of the municipal officers.

Clerks in larger communities need the entire 26 hour period to complete tabulating returns, which means the work is not completed until 10:00 p.m. on the day after election day. It is difficult for these clerks to ensure that a majority of the municipal officers are present at that time.
