24 cials of Temple and Wilton are directed to survey
25 within one year to the effective date of this Act the
26 boundary between the 2 towns to make sure the line
27 conforms to the boundary set when the towns were in-
28 corporated in 1803.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The last survey carried out by the towns of Temple and Wilton appears not to follow the town line established when the towns were incorporated. Since this effects the boundaries of property holders on both sides of the line, the towns are directed to survey the boundary to make sure it is in compliance with the boundaries established by the State.

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
