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- 5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:
 - PL 1983, c. 859, Pt. M, §13, as amended by PL 1984, c. 1, is further amended to read:
 - Sec. 13. Effective date. Section 8 of this Part shall be effective October 1, 1985, provided that the federal excise tax reduction set out in the United States Internal Revenue Code, Section S701(c), as enacted by the United States tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act of 1982, Public Law 97-248, Section 283, is implemented on or before that date. If the reduction of federal excise tax is not so implemented on or before that date, section 8 shall not take effect and shall be repealed. All other sections shall be effective December 15, 1984.
- 20 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 21 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-22 proved.

23 STATEMENT OF FACT

> This bill fulfills the intent of the legislation enacted at the 3rd Special Session of the lilth Legislature, which increased the state excise tax cigarettes by 8¢, by making the 8¢ increase contingent upon the repeal of the 8¢ federal excise tax on cigarettes scheduled for October 1, 1985.

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
