AN ACT to Repeal the Requirement that Certain
Tax Information Appear on Local
Property Tax Bills.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

36 MRSA §507, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 855, §3, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the provision that local property tax bills contain a statement of the amount by which the taxpayer's tax has been reduced by the distribution of state-municipal revenue sharing and state aid for education.
