## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The Maine Milk Commission proposes to provide a 3 minimum wholesale price which discriminates between 4 large and small retail stores even within the same 5 market area. While this is allegedly based upon dif-6 ferences in cost of distribution, the difference in 7 cost is based solely upon number of cases delivered 8 and not on any other factors such as distance from 9 the dairy, availability of transportation facilities and size of vehicle. The purpose of this change in 10 11 the law is to require that all retailers in the same 12 market area be subject to the same minimum wholesale 13 price so that the convenience to the consumer of the small store will not be destroyed by an oppressive 14 15 price differential.

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
