8	Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Laws Relating to the Maine
9	State Retirement System."
10 11	Amend the Bill by inserting after section 24 the following:
12	<pre>'Sec. 25. 5 MRSA \$18061, sub-\$2, \$\$A, as enacted</pre>
13	by PL 1985, c. 801, \$\$5, 7, is amended to read:
14	A. On retirement for reasons other than disabil-
15	ity, the average amount of basic insurance in
16	force for the last 3 years prior to retirement
17	shall be continued in force at no cost to the
18	participant, if he has participated in the group
19	life insurance program for a minimum of 10 years
20	continuously-and-immediatelybeforeretirement.
21	(1) Except as provided in paragraph B, the
22	average amount shall be reduced at the rate
23	of 15% per year to a minimum of 40% of the
24	average amount or \$2,500, whichever is
25	greater.
26	(2) In determining benefits under this sub-
27	chapter, the reductions shall become effec-
28	tive at 12:01 a.m. of the day following the
29	first year anniversary of the date of re-
30	tirement and each succeeding retirement an-
31	niversary thereafter until the minimum has
32	been reached.'
33	Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sec-
34	tions to read consecutively.
35 36	Further amend the Bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 724, L.D. 975

1 'FISCAL NOTE 2 This benefit is already funded and requires no 3 additional cost.' 4 STATEMENT OF FACT 5 This amendment removes the requirement that state employees and teachers have "continuous service imme-diately before retirement" in order to have life in-surance coverage carried into retirement.
