4 Commission established. Resolved: That the Com-
5 mission to Study Special Education is established.
6 The commission shall consist of 9 members, appointed
7 in the following manner: Five members of the Joint
8 Standing Committee on Education, 3 of whom shall be
9 members of the House of Representatives, to be ap-
10 pointed by the Speaker of the House, and 2 of whom
11 shall be members of the Senate, to be appointed by
12 the President of the Senate; and 4 members who are
13 parents of special education students and who belong
14 to parental support groups, to be appointed by the
15 Governor. Legislative members shall receive the leg-
16 islative per diem; other members shall be compensated
17 for actual expenses; and be it further
