4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 29 MRSA §1377 is enacted to read:

7 §1377. Roll bars on public vehicles

8 All municipality, state or county owned vehicles
9 used by law enforcement officers in the course of
10 their duties shall be equipped with roll bars. The
11 Commissioner of Public Safety shall adopt rules pur-
12 suant to the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Ti-
13 tle 5, chapter 375, governing this section.
