1 **AN ACT to Amend Benefits Under the Maine**
2 **State Retirement System for Members of**
3 **the State Police.**

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17852, sub-§4, ¶B, as enacted by**
8 **PL 1985, c. 801, §§5 and 7, is amended to read:**

9 **B. For persons qualifying under section 17851,**
10 **subsection 4, paragraph B, and ~~who retire upon or~~**
11 **~~after reaching the age of 55,~~ the retirement ben-**
12 **efit shall be computed in accordance with subsec-**
13 **tion 1.**

14 **Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §17852, sub-§4, ¶C, as enacted by**
15 **PL 1985, c. 801, §§5 and 7, is repealed.**

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to permit retirement
3 by members of the Maine State Police upon completion
4 of 25 years of service. Presently, full benefits may
5 only be attained after 25 years of service and at-
6 tainment of age 55.
