20 21 22	Whereas, standards for the collection of radon data, testing methodologies, remediation procedures and building construction are not available; and
23 24 25	Whereas, there are many questions of liability which could hinder real estate transactions resulting in economic loss; and
26 27 28	Whereas, a coordinated effort to investigate the problem and to develop a sound program of public education is vital; and

The Governor shall call the first meeting of the commission within 60 days of the effective date of this resolve; and be it further'
