HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1238, L.D. 1690,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Civil Enforcement of the  
Anti-strikebreaker Law to Encourage the Settlement  
and Peaceful Resolution of Labor Disputes."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 5  
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. 26 MRSA §857 is enacted to read:

§857. Exemptions

This subchapter shall not apply to the employment  
of:

1. Security guards. Security guards during a  
labor dispute if the security guards perform security  
guard duties only;

2. Special maintenance work. Special mainte-  
nance work performed by persons employed by the sell-  
er or manufacturer of the equipment maintained or by  
persons who have performed the maintenance work on  
the equipment prior to the beginning of the labor  
dispute; and

3. Permanent employees. Permanent employees of  
the employer involved in the labor dispute regardless  
of their usual occupation or duty station.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

2           The purpose of the amendment is to exempt securi-  
3 ty guard services, normal maintenance work which has  
4 been traditionally contracted to the same party and  
5 permanent employees of the employer, brought in from  
6 other locations during the dispute, from the law.
