When a child 4 years of age or older, but less than 12 13 years of age, is a passenger in a motor vehicle, which is required by the United States Department of Transportation to be equipped with seat belts, the operator of the motor vehicle shall have the child properly secured in a seat belt or in a child safety seat that meets the requirements set out in 49 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 571.
25 26 27 28	Sec. 2. Effective date. The Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, section 1368-C, subsection 1, as amended in this Act, shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'
