IN THE'YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

1 2 3	AN ACT to Abolish the Maine Turnpike Authority.
4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Main e as follows:
6	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA c. 24, as amended, is repealed.
7 8	Sec. 2. Transition. Any rights, duties, obligations and powers belonging to the Maine Turnpike

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1 Authority shall be transferred to and assumed by the Department of Transportation. The department shall submit a report, together with any necessary 2 3 4 implementing legislation, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over 5 transportation not later than January 31, 1989, to accomplish this transition. This report shall include an organizational plan and the mechanisms necessary for the department to assume all the rights, duties, obligations and powers of the Maine Turnpike Authority 6 7 8 9 10 11 by January 1, 1990.

Sec. 3. Effective date. Section 1 of this Act 12 13 shall take effect January 1, 1990.

STATEMENT OF FACT

15 This bill abolishes the Maine Turnpike Authority in 2 years and transfers duties and operation of the 16 17 roadway to the Department of Transportation. The 18 department is required to submit a plan by January 31, 1989, which will accomplish such a transfer. 19

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
