SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A "
to H.P. 1703, L.D. 2340, Bill, "AN ACT to Promote
Economic Development in the State by Enhancing
Employment Opportunities for Maine People."

Amend the amendment in section 4 in that part
designated "§3779." in subsection 1 by striking out
all of the first 12 lines (page 1, lines 28 to 29 and
page 2, lines 1 to 10 in amendment) and inserting in
their place the following:

'1. Eligibility. The department shall provide
extended medical assistance to former recipients of
the Aid to Families with Dependent Children or
supplemental security income programs who have become
ineligible for financial assistance under those
programs because of earnings from employment.
Extended medical assistance shall be limited to 18
months beginning with the month in which financial
ineligibility begins and shall be provided only in
months in which the former recipient is employed.'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in that
part designated "§3779." in subsection 2 in the last 2
lines (page 3, lines 23 and 24 in amendment) by
striking out the following: "Medicaid assistance." and
inserting in their place the following: "assistance
from the Aid to Families with Dependent Children or
supplemental security income programs."

1 Further amend the amendment in section 4 in that
2 part designated "§3779." in subsection 4 by striking
3 out all of paragraph B (page 4, lines 9 and 10 in
4 amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

5 'B. The number of former recipients of Aid to
6 Families with Dependent Children or supplemental
7 security income participating in the program;'


8 Further amend the amendment in section 5 in the
9 5th line from the end (page 5, line 3 in amendment) by
10 striking out the following: "Medicaid" and inserting
11 in its place the following: 'Aid to Families with
12 Dependent Children or supplemental security income'

13 Further amend the amendment in the fiscal note in
14 the 4th line (page 5, line 14 in amendment) by
15 inserting after the following: "benefits to" the
16 following: 'former recipients of' and in the 5th line
17 (page 5, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the
18 following: "other eligible clients," and inserting in
19 their place the following: 'supplemental security
20 income,'

21 STATEMENT OF FACT

22 This amendment is intended to clarify the
23 committee amendment to make clear that eligibility for
24 this program begins when financial assistance from Aid
25 to Families with Dependent Children or supplemental
26 security income is lost due to employment.
