1 AN ACT to Permit Fly-Fishing Only on a
2 Portion of the St. Croix River.
3

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 12 MRSA §7553-A is enacted to read:

7 §7553-A. Fly-fishing on the St. Croix River

1 Fly-fishing only is permitted on that part of the
2 St. Croix River from the Milltown Dam in Calais to
3 2,600 feet downstream from that dam.

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 Currently, spin casting fishermen are fishing
6 illegally for Atlantic salmon on the St. Croix River
7 with artificial lures. This bill addresses that
8 problem by providing for fly-fishing only on the St.
9 Croix River for 2,600 feet below the Milltown Dam in
10 Calais.
