COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1706, L.D. 2343,
Bill, "AN ACT to Ensure Local Participation on the
Radiological Emergency Preparedness Committee."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after
the amending clause and inserting in its place the
following:

'1. Created. There is created a Radiological
Emergency Preparedness Committee, as established by
Title 5, section 12004, subsection 10, which is
composed of 9 voting members as listed in this
subsection:

A. One member representing evacuation area fire
departments;

B. One member representing evacuation area law
enforcement agencies;

C. One member representing evacuation area
ambulance services;

D. One member representing the Lincoln County
Emergency Management Agency;

E. One member representing the Sagadahoc County
Emergency Management Agency;

1 F. The license holder for the Maine Yankee
2 Nuclear Power Plant or the license holder's
3 designee;

4 G. The Director of the Maine Emergency Management
5 Agency or the director's designee;

6 H. The Commissioner of Public Safety or the
7 commissioner's designee; and

8 I. The Director of Health Engineering or the
9 director's designee.

10 The county commissioners of Sagadahoc and Lincoln
11 counties shall designate the members to represent the
12 categories listed in paragraphs A to E. The
13 commissioners shall choose these members from a list
14 of nominations made by the agencies listed in those
15 paragraphs.'

16 Statement of Fact

17 The purpose of the amendment is to eliminate the
18 members designated by the Governor, President of the
19 Senate and Speaker of the House. The amendment adds a
20 member from the Sagadahoc County Emergency Management
21 Agency. The amendment provides a selection mechanism
22 for the members representing the local and county
23 agencies to be represented on the committee.
