8 Bill, "AN ACT to Ensure Local Participation on the
9 Radiological Emergency Preparedness Committee."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after
11 the enacting clause and inserting in its place the
12 following:

'37-B MRSA §954, sub-§1, ¶D, as repealed and
14 replaced by PL 1985, c. 737, Pt. A, §107, is amended
15 to read:

D. Three public members, one designated by the
17 Governor, one designated by the President of the
18 Senate and one designated by the Speaker of the
19 House of Representatives. Each public member
20 shall be a resident of the Emergency Planning Zone
21 and, insofar as possible, one shall be a
22 representative of a law enforcement agency, one a
23 representative of a fire department and one a
24 representative of ambulance service personnel; and'


