- Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1535, sub-§1, as enacted by PL
  1987, c. 530, §4, is amended to read:
  - 1. Assessment. The authority shall assess any

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nuclear plant within the State for the full cost of 1 planning, siting, licensing and construction of a 2 3 disposal facility, low-level radioactive waste 4 including reasonable reserves for unforeseen 5 contingencies. The assessment shall not exceed 6 shall follows: 510,000,000 and be assessed 85 7 \$1,500,000 on March 1, 1988; \$2,500,000 on March 1, 8 1989; \$2,000,000 on March 1, 1991; \$2,000,000 on March 17 1992. The amount assessed shall be paid within 30 9 10 days of assessment. This assessment shall deposited in the Low-level Radioactive Waste Facility 11 12 Fund.

15 User fees. All users of а low-level 16 radioactive waste disposal facility shall be assessed a user fee calculated in accordance with subsections 2 17 User fees established under this section 18 and 3. shall be designed to 19 raise \$1,000,000 per sufficient funds to meet operational costs. 20 21 shall not be collected in excess of that amount or, if collected, shall be returned to the users within 15 22 23 days of receipt. The authority shall establish, by 24 rule, a schedule of fees to be paid by all users of a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility. 25

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill amends the Maine Low-Level Radioactive Waste Authority Act to require nuclear plants to provide for full capital and operational costs of low-level waste storage. This will ensure that the State's taxpayers are protected from liability and are not saddled with undue financial burdens due to the generation of radioactive waste.

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
