The Bureau of Public Services shall submit a report and any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Business Legislation of the First Regular Session of the 114th Legislature on January 15, 1989, concerning the effectiveness of the definition of "wine cooler" contained in section 1 of this Act and its implementation.'

## The purpose of this amendment is to simplify the definition of wine cooler by deleting the reference to the 3% requirement of water. The amendment also requires the Bureau of Public Services to report back to the Joint Standing Committee on Business Legislation on January 15, 1989, regarding the effectiveness of the definition of wine cooler and its implementation.
