If this bill is enacted, the Department of Administration anticipates that a large number of State Government projects would be affected. Because of the difficulty in adapting older structures to handicapped standards, many renovation projects would become major projects. While it is impossible to project the precise fiscal impact, it is estimated that this could represent a major cost for the State.
