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An Act to Provide Emergency Shelter Services to Runaway and Homeless Youth.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

**Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

**HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF**

**Bureau of Child and Family Services**

All Other \$225,000

Provides funds to create an emergency shelter, in a region of the State that does not currently have an emergency shelter, which will house homeless and runaway youth 10 to 17 years of age.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill provides funds to the Department of Human Services, Bureau of Child and Family Services, to create an emergency shelter for homeless and runaway youth.
