HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 746,
L.D. 1950, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Annexation of Land
Adjacent to the Town of East Millinocket"

Amend the amendment in the 6th indented paragraph by
striking out all of the last sentence (page 2, lines 22 to 25 in
amendment)

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 6th
indented paragraph the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of
the 6th paragraph (page 2, lines 18 to 22 in L.D.) and inserting
in its place the following:

'If the referendum fails, it may not be submitted again to
the voters under the provisions of this Act.' '

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes an unnecessary minimum turnout
provision in the referendum.
