STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

An Act to Require the State to Pay a Portion of Retired State Employees' Medicare Costs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA §285, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

9. Supplemental coverage: Medicare-eligible retirees. For
those retirees who are otherwise eligible for coverage under this section, but are also eligible for Medicare, the Maine State
8 Retirement System shall pay 30% of only the retirees' share of the premiums for Medicare Part B and a supplemental group policy
10 which has the effect of making the deductibles and coverages for retirees eligible for Medicare equal to those provided retirees
12 ineligible for Medicare under this section.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill requires the Maine State Retirement System to pay 30% of Medicare premiums of state retirees and provide 20 supplemental insurance to equalize Medicare benefits with the state plan.
