COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 760, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Allow the State Police to Recover Funds Expended for Presidential Security"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This legislation authorizes the State Police to receive reimbursement from federal agencies for providing presidential security. It authorizes the Department of Public Safety to keep those reimbursements in a dedicated account to offset the costs of providing such service. The exact amount of reimbursements in fiscal year 1989-90 and fiscal year 1990-91 is not known at this time.'
