L.D. 1987, Bill, "An Act to Enable the Department of Marine
Resources to Issue Identification Tags for Lobster Gear"

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of the bill repeals the sunset provision placed on
the collection of fees for lobster trap identification tags on
Swan's Island. This amendment allows the continuance of the
collection of dedicated revenue of \$1,362 annually, which is
currently allocated.'
