An Act to Enable the Department of Marine Resources to Issue Identification Tags for Lobster Gear.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA $\S6442$, 3rd \P , as amended by PL 1985, c. 540, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to ensure the continuance of the collection of lobster trap identification tag fees by the Department of Marine Resources which are used in the administration of the Swan's Island Experimental Trap Limit Frogram. This bill repeals the sunset provision placed on the collection of fees for lobster trap identification tags.
