HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 769,  
L.D. 1994, Bill, "An Act to Provide for a Job Development  
Training Funding Capability within the Resources of the State  
Contingent Account"

Amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph after the title in  
the last line (page 1, line 33 in amendment) by inserting after  
the following: "workers." the following: 'In fiscal year 1989-90,  
an additional \$75,000 of this amount may also be allocated for  
immediate job training, unemployment counseling, retraining and  
other assistance to displaced workers in the mid-coast area of  
the State.'

This amendment allows an additional \$75,000 from the  
existing State Contingent Account to be used in fiscal year  
1989-90 for job training and assistance to displaced workers in  
the mid-coast area.
