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**RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine  
to Provide State Funding of any Mandate Imposed on Municipalities.**

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

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4       This resolution amends the Constitution of Maine to require  
the State to fund state mandates. It also provides that a  
6       municipality is not obligated to implement a state mandate  
imposed by statute, by executive order or by rule unless the  
Legislature appropriates the amount necessary to reimburse the  
8       municipality the cost of the mandate.
