COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 122, L.D. 224, "RESOLUTION,  
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Protect  
the Assets of State Retirement Plans"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the  
following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to  
referendum will vary according to the number of referenda. The  
estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to six referenda  
are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an  
additional \$6,500.

If approved by the voters, this proposal would not allow the  
State to realize teacher retirement rate savings resulting from  
legislative action within the biennium in which the action was  
taken.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment adds the required fiscal note to the bill.
