An Act Concerning Campaign Sign Posts.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§1, ¶H, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 318,
§3, is amended to read:

H. Signs bearing political messages relating to an election, primary or referendum, provided that these signs may not be placed within the right-of-way prior to 6 weeks before the election, primary or referendum to which they relate and must be removed by the candidate or political committee not later than one week thereafter. Wire may not be used to attach these signs to any surface.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill prohibits using wire on political advertising sign posts.
