COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 379, L.D. 553, Bill, "An Act to Protect Stone Walls, Stone Impoundments and Timber Bridges of Historical Significance"

Amend the bill in paragraph I in the first line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "including" the following: 'at the discretion of the municipality.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows municipalities to include stone walls, stone impoundments and timber bridges of historical significance within their comprehensive plans at their discretion.
