

 $26\ MRSA$  §774, as amended by PL 1989, c. 700, Pt. A, §102, is further amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph a new paragraph to read:

A person under 18 years of age who is enrolled in school may not be employed, permitted or suffered to work in, about or in connection with any gainful occupation for more than 8 hours in any one day, more than 40 hours in any one week or more than 6 consecutive days in any one week during summer school vacation or other school vacation periods lasting one week or longer.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill limits the number of hours that persons under 18 years of age who are enrolled in school may work during school vacations.
